Notices to the Members of TMC:

Currently, Ibaraki is under the state of priority measures to prevent the spread of virus. We ask you to be extra careful as we remind you that the pastor is taking PCR tests every week.

Join us in taking precausions to check your health before coming to church, temperature checks, sanitizing hands before and after service, vent out the rooms when in use, eating diagonally across or keeping social distancing, to leave the worship hall quickly for sanitizing and ventilation, huming the praise, and other precausions for others and new comers.

If/When someone close is infected:

- 1. You or someone close to you is infected (tested positive on PCR test) or are considered to have in contact with the infected.
- 2. If you have come in contact with the infected or high possiblity of the infected for some time (15 minutes without mask).
- 3. Suspected of infected and have taken PCR test.

Please notify the church. We promise to becareful with the information entrusted to us. The response of the church (which will differ depending on the severity of the provided information) will be notified when the information is given.

If you have found it difficult due to sudden hospitalization or other issues, please feel free to contact us.

Please continue to pray for the four projects at church, the downsizing of Covid; we will be able to join together with our brothers and sisters in fellowship soon. Please beware of your safety.
