World Peace Prayer Requests: Japan

- 1. For Doumei Denomination to remember the sin of participating in idol worshipping and invading war and to promise never to make the same mistake. For our country to continue to seek reconciliation with the countries that was invaded, violated, and enforced into idol worshippping.
- 2. To be agressively joining the duties of the society as a Christian member responsible for the social and political mission of the church standing firmly on evangelical doctrine.
- 3. For the politicians of this country to work with fairness and righteousness, to uphold the sovereignty of the people, to value the human rights, to not change the constitution that will alter the principle of pacifism that currently exists. And if it fails and the constitution changes, for the Christians to stand firm on their faith.
- 4. For SDF members who are enforced the ideology of the emperor worshipping to be given the freedom of faith, for the non-Japanese members in our community to be treated as our neighbor and loved as our own, and for the Okinawan people who are enforced the base to be given the understanding they deserve.
- 5. To remember the atomic holocost of August 6th, 9th, the disaster of Fukushima nuclear power plant on March 11th, and the victims of the above. For Japan to join the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.

Currently, Ibaraki is under the state of priority measures to prevent the spread of virus. We ask you to be extra careful as we remind you that the pastor is taking PCR tests every week.
