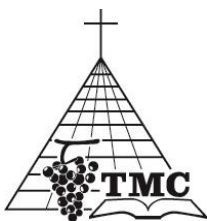

3. For the missionaries working in Christian persecuting countries and their works and the churches supporting the religious refugees in Japan to be encouraged and be able to do the work of God.
