1. Vision (discernment and sensing of kairos time / forward thinking / thinking three steps ahead)

 4. Compassion (serving others) ❤️
 5. Charisma (focused, courageous, selfless, witty - ex) Ronald Reagan, Donald Trump) ✨
 6. Integrity (authentic) 💎
 7. Knowledge through experience (invest in experience, not in stuff) 📖
 8. Hard working / Preparation (work ethics) 🏠
 9. Message delivery (articulate communication / fluent in the global language called 'English') 🗣️ 💬 🗑️ 🚚
 10. Decisive and smart (efficient) actions 🏃 through courage and discipline 📏
